Dear NYS Association of PBAs Member,

The New York State Association of PBAs Convention/ Seminar will take place Wednesday, July 12th - Friday, July 14th, 2017 at Caesars Palace in Atlantic City, New Jersey.

Convention/Seminar Fee: A \$100.00 fee per person must be paid by anyone attending the Convention/Seminar. Complete the enclosed registration form and submit with payment. Passes will be issued to registered participants for all events.

Member Units should make their room reservations directly with Caesars. This can be done by calling the reservations department at 888-516-2215 and requesting group code SC07NY. You may also make reservations online by the following internet link:

The only room type available this year is "Run of House". The cost is \$130.00 per night plus taxes and fees. There is also a daily resort fee of \$24.00 per room. This rate includes a \$5.00 voucher towards self-parking, basic in room WIFI and (2) guest passes per day to the fitness center. There are a limited amount of rooms available on Tuesday, July 11th and Friday, July 14th for anyone wishing to extend their stay. The cutoff date for room reservations is June 23, 2017. If you choose to Valet Park, a \$10.00 per day parking fee will be paid directly to Caesars Palace.

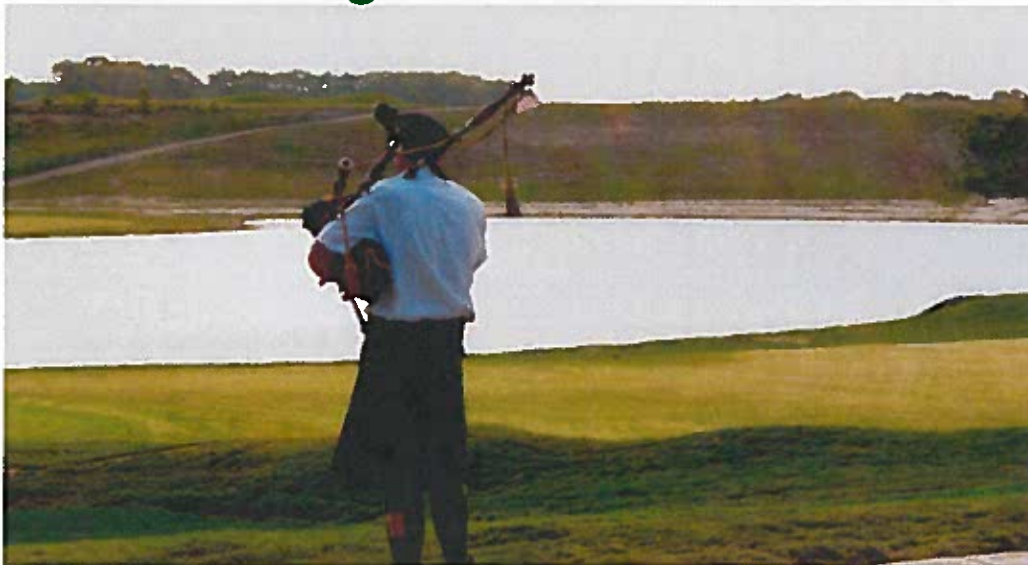
